LEADING OFF: Halos have dropped three straight games and four of last five...Angels looking to avoid being swept in a four-game series vs. NYY since July 21-24, 1994 in Anaheim... Tonight LAA plays the final game (2-4) of a seven-game road trip to Pittsburgh (2-1) and New York Yankees (0-3)...Halos are 14-16 on road, 12-17 at home...**LAA is 1-8 vs. A.L. East foes...**Halos are 6-11-3 in 20 series in 2016 (3-5-2 on road)... LAA returns home tomorrow to open a six-game homestand vs. Cleveland (June 10-12) and Minnesota (June 13-15).

DRAFT DAY: The 2016 MLB Draft starts with live coverage from MLB Network's Studio 42 tonight at 7 PM ET...Angels will make two selections today (1st round – 16th overall & 2nd round – 60th overall)...Halos will be represented at the Draft by former pitcher Jim Abbott and scout Ryan Leahy...The Angels selected a pitcher with 10 of their first 11 picks in 2013 and each of their first five picks in 2014. In 2015, LAA selected a position player with 12 of first 14 picks...12 current 40-man Angels were drafted in the first round: **Jered Weaver, C.J. Cron, Mike Trout, Cam Bedrosian, Tyler Skaggs, Garrett Richards, David Huff, Huston Street, Cliff Pennington, Andrew Heaney** (60-day DL), **Tim Lincecum** and **Kaleb Cowart**.

NOW YOU KNOW: With his third inning walk Monday, **Mike Trout** became just sixth player since 1901 to log 400 BB and score 500 runs prior to age-25 season: **Mel Ott, Mickey Mantle, Ted Williams, Jimmie Foxx** and **Arky Vaughan**.

SHOE SHINES: **Matt Shoemaker** has an active streak of 39 strikeouts since his last walk (franchise record)...**132 batters faced in that span since last walk...**Joins **Curt Schilling** (May 13-June 3, 2002) as only pitchers since 1913, to go 7+ IP, with 6+ strikeouts and zero walks in four consecutive starts...**First pitcher in Angels' history with four straight starts with 6+ SO and zero walks.**

ANGELS ACQUIRE VALDEZ: On Tuesday the Angels acquired RHP **Jose Valdez** from Detroit for cash considerations and optioned him to Salt Lake. To make room on the 40-man, LHP **Chris Jones** was designated for assignment.

THIS N' THAT: On Tuesday, LHP **David Huff** became the 39th player to appear with the Halos in 2016...**Trout** leads all A.L. outfielders with 1,344,578 All-Star votes...**Halos have hit into an MLB-most 57 double plays (59 G)**...15 pickoffs by Angels' pitching this season leads Majors (no MLB team has more than 9 PO)...**Halo batters have fewest strikeouts in all of baseball (353).**

REHAB UPDATES: **Tim Lincecum** is scheduled to make his third Triple-A start with Salt Lake at Fresno Sunday...**He made his second outing Tuesday** (5 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 3 BB, 6 SO; 95 pitches)...**Andrelton Simmons** is on a rehab assignment with single-A Inland Empire...He is likely to be activated over the weekend...LHP **Tyler Skaggs** pitched five innings in extended Spring Training in Arizona yesterday and will get another start there before moving to a rehab assignment.

@ YANKEES: **Gregorio Petit** is hitting .464 (13/28) in his career at Yankee Stadium...Halos are 3-14 in last 17 games in the Bronx (have dropped last eight here, longest active streak in the Bronx)...Angels are 8-23 all-time at new Yankee Stadium (since 2009)...**Yankees have claimed last five season series...**Since 2008, Angels are 21-12 at home vs. Yanks... Halos are 29-16 in last 45 games vs. New York at *Angel Stadium (since 2005)*...**Yankees and Angels are meeting this late in a season with each sporting sub-.500 records for first time since August 23, 1992.**

ROAD RAGE: **Kole Calhoun** owns a .366 (41/112) clip on the road compared to .229 (24/105) average at home...The .366 road clip ranks second in A.L. (min. 100 AB).

INDIANS ON DECK: Indians claimed 2015 series 4-2...**LAA has won five of last six meetings at Angel Stadium...**Club will meet at Progressive Field for a four-game series Aug. 11-14...The clubs have split the last 38 overall meetings (19-19).

WELCOMED ADDITION: Since the start of May, **Yunel Escobar** is batting .328 (41/125)...His 68 hits this season are second-most among A.L. third basemen...**Escobar has an OBP of .361 batting in the leadoff spot (LAA leadoff batters posted OBP of .280 in 2015).**

VIVA VENEZUELA! Angels' current active roster features six players from Venezuela (**J. Alvarez, J. Chacin, C. Perez, G. Petit, R. Ortega** and **D. Guerra**).

HOT HALOS: **Gregorio Petit** is batting .435 (10/23) with five runs, six doubles, one HR and five RBI in seven games of June (7G)...**Has multiple hits each of last four games, longest such streak of his career and longest by an Angel this season...**He has six doubles over his last seven affairs...**Kole Calhoun** has scored 25 runs his last 25 games...He is batting .326 (44/135) with 28 runs, seven doubles, two triples, five HR and 24 RBI over his last 35 games...**Rafael Ortega** has hits in 22 of last 29 games...**Albert Pujols** is batting .312 (30/98) with four doubles, six HR and 23 RBI his last 25 contests.

THE RUN AROUND: Club has tallied seven or more runs in 12 of last 26 games (four times in previous 33 affairs)...**LAA has plated 141 runs the last 26 games (5.4 per).**

M*A*S*H* UNIT: Halos currently have 10 players on the disabled list...RHP **Joe Smith** (left hamstring strain), RHP **Nick Tropeano** (right shoulder tightness), INF **Cliff Pennington** (left hamstring strain), C **Geovany Soto** (right meniscus tear; surgery), SS **Andrelton Simmons** (ulnar collateral ligament tear; left thumb), RHP **Garrett Richards** (right elbow UCL), LHP **Andrew Heaney** (left forearm strain), LHP **C.J. Wilson** (left shoulder inflammation), OF **Craig Gentry** (right lumbar spine strain & personal medical condition) and OF **Daniel Nava** (left groin strain)...**LHP Tyler Skaggs (recovery TJ surgery) is on disabled list with Salt Lake.**

THE MANAGER: **Mike Scioscia** is the longest tenured manager in the Majors (17th season) and the only active manager to collect over 1,000 victories with a single club...His 17 years with the Angels are tied with **Sparky Anderson (Detroit, 1979-95)** for second longest tenure with an A.L. team (trailing only **Connie Mack's** 50 seasons with Philadelphia)...**Scioscia's** 1,442 wins rank 24th on the MLB all-time list (23rd is **Earl Weaver**; 1,481).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER – RHP JHOULYS CHACIN

1-1, 3.73 ERA (with Angels)

First career appearance vs. Yankees

- Making 11th Major League start of the season and sixth with Angels.
- **HALO JHOULYS:** Acquired from Atlanta on May 11 in exchange for minor league LHP Adam McCreery.
- **LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in decision in last start Saturday at Pittsburgh after tossing five innings and allowing three earned runs on six hits with four walks and one strikeout.
- **COMPLETE GAME:** Earned the win on May 30 vs. Tigers after tossing a complete game four-hitter and carried a shutout into the 9th inning...Lone run allowed came on sac fly in 9th inning...**Retired each of first 17 batters faced...**Recorded season-high 10 strikeouts, marking second career double-digit strikeout game...Third career complete game.
- **GOING GLOBAL:** Native of Maracaibo, VZ...Became first Venezuelan born pitcher to make a start for Angels since **Kelvim Escobar** on June 6, 2009 at Detroit...He is the fifth Venezuelan starting pitcher in Angels history, joining Escobar (2004-09), **Anthony Ortega** (2009), **Urbano Lugo** (1985-87) and **Luis Sanchez** (1983).
- **HOMERLESS STREAK:** Had a streak of 30.1 consecutive innings without allowing a home run come to an end on May 4 at NYM...Streak spanned from Sept. 21, 2015 – May 4, 2016...Snapped by Mets catcher **Rene Rivera** in 2nd inning.
- **WITH THE BRAVES:** In five starts for Atlanta this year, went 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA (26.2 IP – 16 ER)...Both losses came against the Mets...Allowed three-or-fewer runs in four of the five starts...Recorded 27 strikeouts while walking eight.
- **FIRST IMPRESSIONS:** Earned the win in Braves debut on April 12 at Washington after tossing six scoreless innings and allowing just five hits and no walks with eight strikeouts on just 69 pitches...*Became second Braves pitcher since at least 1988 to strike out 8+ batters on 69-or-fewer pitches, joining Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz who did so twice...Additionally, he became the only pitcher since at least 1988 to toss 6+ innings with 8+ strikeouts on 69-or-fewer pitches.*
- **MINOR START:** Began regular season with Triple-A Gwinnett and made one start on April 7 at Norfolk...Earned the win after tossing 7.2 scoreless innings and allowing five hits and two walks with seven strikeouts.
- **NO WALKING:** Did not walk a batter in Angels debut (7 IP)...Had streak of 12.1 consecutive innings pitched without walking a batter from Sept. 27, 2015 – April 17, 2016...Recorded 15 strikeouts in that span.
- **VS. YANKEES:** Tonight marks first career start vs. Yankees... NYY is one of four teams he has never faced in Majors (also, White Sox, Rockies and Blue Jays).
- **AT YANKEE STADIUM:** Tonight marks first career appearance in the Bronx...Yankee Stadium is the 25th different ballpark he will pitch in.
- **CAREER NOTES:** In 139 career Major League games (123 starts), has gone 42-52 with a 3.82 ERA (756.2 IP – 321 ER) across eight seasons with the Rockies (2009-14), Diamondbacks (2015), Braves (2016) and Angels (2016).
