TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Mets play game two of this four game series tonight... **RHP Johnny Cueto** will be seeking his first win since July 6...during his current six-start winless stretch, he's 0-2 with a 4.84 ERA (19er, 35.1ip)... **RHP Seth Lugo** will be making his first Major League start for the Mets.

SECOND HALF STRUGGLES: The Giants have gone just 10-21 (.323) in the second half (5-9 at home, 5-12 on the road), the worst record in baseball...eight of the 21 losses have been by one run and 12 have been by two runs or fewer...San Francisco has just one series win in the second half, going 1-8-1 (win-lost-split) in 10 series.

MAKING HISTORY: Last night, **LHP Madison Bumgarner** became the third pitcher in Major League history to allow a grand slam and then hit a go-ahead homer in the subsequent half inning...Boston's Fred Klobedanz did that against New York on Sept. 12, 1896 and the Reds' Hal Jeffcoat, a converted outfielder, did it on May 26, 1957 (*Elias*).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: **RHP Johnny Cueto** has allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of his last five starts against the Mets (including the postseason), fashioning a 1.75 ERA (7er, 36.0ip) in this span...the last time Cueto faced New York was in Game Two of the World Series last season in which he went the distance while allowing one run on two hits to lead the Royals to a 7-1 victory.

JUST IN CASE: The last time the Giants won back-to-back starts by Bumgarner and Cueto was June 30 at Oakland (Bumgarner) and July 1 at Arizona (Cueto).

PAGAN HIT STREAK REACHES 16: **OF Angel Pagan** enters tonight's game with a 16 game hitting streak, during which he's hitting .348 (23-for-66) with seven extra base hits (five doubles, two homers) and five RBI...it's the longest hitting streak by a Giants player this season and the longest active streak in the Majors.

WITH THE BATS: The Giants have scored 36 runs in their past six games, averaging 6.0 runs a game during this span.

WE PLAY THEM CLOSE: The Giants have played 42 one-run game this season, the most such games for any National League team (24-18 record in those games)... since the All-Star break, the Giants are 4-8 in one-run contests.

TOO MANY BLOWN LEADS: The Giants have six losses this season after leading by four-or-more runs, which are the most among all clubs...SF had just five such losses in their prior two seasons combined (*ESPN Stats and Info*).

BATTING WITH RISP: Since the second half, the Giants are batting just .209 (62-for-296) with runners in scoring position, the second-lowest figure in the Majors ahead of only the Mets (.185)...however, SF has been much better in these situations as of late, batting .303 (23-for-76) in their past six games.

RAISE THE FLAG: In honor of Tony Bennett's 90th birthday, which was on Aug. 3, the Giants have announced the installation of a victory flag, which will be raised in Willie Mays Plaza after every Giants home win...the flag's artwork features a Giants logo and a heart - symbolizing the heart of San Francisco.

SELLOUT STREAK AT AT&T PARK: The Giants have sold out their last 468 regular season games at AT&T Park, dating back to Oct. 1, 2010 vs. San Diego...the Giants' sellout streak is the longest active home streak in the Majors and ranks as the second-longest consecutive regular season sellout streak in MLB history behind the Boston Red Sox (794 dates).

DON'T FORGET: This Sunday's game has been selected by ESPN as the Sunday Night Game of the Week...game time has been moved from 1:05 p.m. (PT) to 5:08 p.m. (PT).

MANAGER BRUCE BOCHY

Bruce Bochy is in his 10th season at the helm of the Giants...his only predecessors to reach double figures were **John McGraw** (1902-32), **Bill Terry** (1932-41) and **Dusty Baker** (1993-2002)...SF has posted an 818-761 (.518) record during his 10-year tenure...his 1,769 victories are the highest total by an active manager and are tied with Jim Leyland for 15th place on the all-time list...Bochy is one of 10 managers in ML history to win three World Series titles...the other nine are in the Hall of Fame.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#47 RHP Johnny Cueto
5-11, 220, 30 years old (February 15, 1986)
13-3 Record, 2.97 ERA

- The two-time All-Star (2014 and 2016) has gone 13-3 with a 2.97 ERA, four complete games, 150 strikeouts and 33 walks in 24 starts...signed a six-year contract (through 2021) with SF this off-season (December 16).
- The Giants are 18-6 in his outings this season...SF has dropped four of his last six starts after winning 16 of his first 18 outings of the season.
- Has not earned a win since July 6 at Colorado...during his six-start winless stretch he's gone 0-2 with a 4.84 ERA (19er, 35.1ip)...has received 14 runs of support (3.57 RSA) during this span.
- Went 13-1 with a 2.47 ERA (36er, 131.1ip) in 18 starts in the first half.
- Received a no-decision in his last outing last Sunday...threw 6.2 innings, allowing three runs on eight hits with four strikeouts...left the game with a 7-3 lead, but the bullpen allowed five runs in 2.1 innings to give the Giants' an 8-7 loss to Baltimore.
- Has surrendered nine home runs in his last nine outings after allowing just three homers in his first 15 starts of the season.
- Left-handed batters are hitting .339 (21-for-62) off him over his last six games, while righties are just 7-for-their-last-41 (.171) off him.
- Is 4-1 with a 2.12 ERA (16er, 68.0ip) and a .228 opponents average against in his last nine starts at AT&T Park.
- Owns a 3-4 record with a 4.02 ERA (29er, 65.0ip) in 11 career starts against the Mets...is 3-2 with a 2.05 ERA (10er,44.0ip) over his last seven games versus New York.
- Was the starting pitcher for the NL in the All-Star game and became the eighth pitcher in Giants franchise history to start an All-Star game (ninth time), joining **Carl Hubbell** (1934), **Juan Marichal** (1965 and 1967), **Vida Blue** (1978), **Rick Reuschel** (1989), **Jason Schmidt** (2003), **Tim Lincecum** (2009) and **Matt Cain** (2012).

NOTES: 27-year-old will make his fourth start in a Giants uniform and his 25th overall this season...is 0-2 with a 4.50 ERA (9er, 18.0ip) in his three starts with SF and is 7-9 with a 4.14 ERA overall this season in 24 starts with the Rays and Giants...was acquired from Tampa Bay at the trade deadline on July 31 in exchange for IF Matt Duffy and minor leaguer IF Lucius Fox and RHP Michael Santos...last pitched Monday night against the Pirates and had his string of eight straight quality starts snapped as he allowed five runs on six hits in 6.0 innings of an 8-5 loss...marked his first-ever start at AT&T Park...has never faced the Mets in his career.
